Dr. Anil Henry

We were so fortunate to have Dr. Anil Henry, missionary and surgeon from India, visit with us July 24th and 25th. He visited with a group of church members Saturday evening over dinner at Osage National and with another group after church on Sunday at Bob Evans' restaurant. There is a long waiting list of churches who want him to come to their church. Many will be disappointed because his time is booked and limited.

On Sunday morning at each church service he spoke about himself and his mission area. Between services he showed pictures of his parents who were formerly missionaries in India, his wife Terry, 17 yr old daughter and 12 yr old twin sons. All were born in the U.S. His father and his wife were born in India. All of his family are citizens of the United States. Anil practiced medicine in the U.S. for a few years and then.....

Seven years ago, Global Missions sent Anil (a-neal), Terry and their family to India to take over a long neglected hospital. The pictures of the hospital and private home were daunting to say the least! But Anil and his wife with the help of many others completely renovated the buildings. There is now an out-patient clinic, a hospital, 3 operating rooms, a laboratory, an x-ray area, a pharmacy, and other areas that are necessary for up-to-date health care. Anil explained that they sterilize and re-use many products that are thrown away in the United States.

Cotton drapes and gowns are used rather than the paper throw-aways used in the United States. Each suture is carefully opened only as needed, rather than opening a variety to choose from as is common in our operating rooms. Used water is saved and re-used for watering the garden, flushing toilets, etc.

In addition to the clinic, there is a school for 2500 children, a 3-year nursing program are in operation and a church is being currently. Renovated.

India is mostly Hindu, a small percentage Muslim, and an even smaller percentage Christian. It is dangerous to be Christian in such a situation. Christians believe in the equality of all people. This makes higher caste Hindus very unhappy. They do not like their lowest class being taught to read and trained in a profession. Consequently the hospital and other buildings are a "compound" protected by two police dogs.

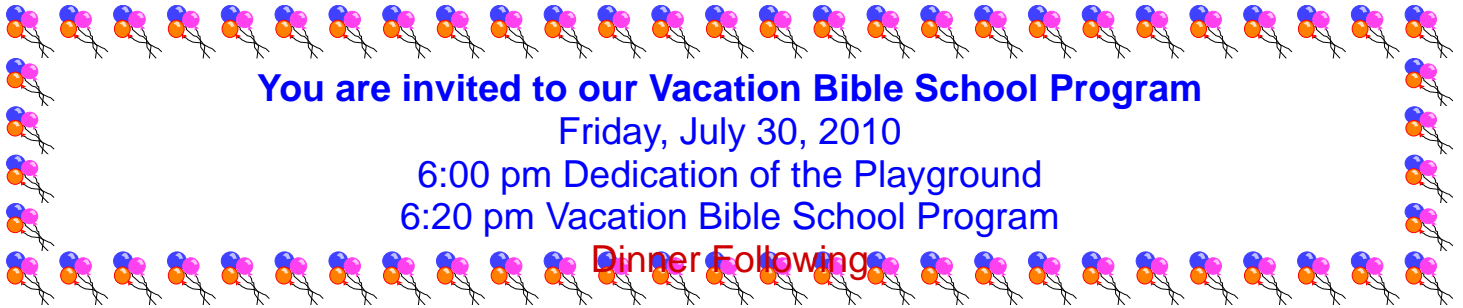

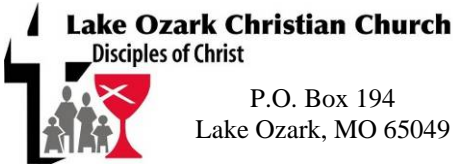
