

Highlights from the Leadership Council meeting November 11, 2021

- Guests George Neville and Chris Harper attended the meeting to go over the boy scouts/cub scouts Charter process. Once all information was heard a motion to extend our Scouting Charter agreement for 2022 was approved. As well as George remaining as our Chartered Organization Representative.
- Matt Redd presented the 2022 proposed Budget for LOCC.
- Todd Miller went over the driveway resurfacing information. He also mentioned a LOCC Clean Up day is needed.
- Guest Susan Bowden provided a "work in progress" security document for LOCC. This will take time, but as portions are complete and approved, they will be implemented. She will be meeting with the Fire Marshall along with two security companies for their guidance on what is required and recommended for safety for our church.

Highlights from the Semi-Annual Congregational Meeting November 14, 2021

- Chair Greg Weingart opened the meeting by stating the Fall Congregational meeting would include the election of open positions on the Leadership Council, Deacons/Elders along with the church budget. A motion was made to elect everyone on the ballot and all approved.
- Treasurer Matt Redd presented a detailed financial report along with the 2022 Budget for approval. A motion to approve the 2022 budget as presented was made and all approved.
- Todd Miller provided the property report which includes the resurfacing of the parking lot along with us having a company to complete routine maintenance on the HVAC system which should save money. In addition, a LOCC Clean-Up date would be coming in the near future.
- Audrey Tanner gave an update on the Shelter in a Storm/Pantry of Blessings which included a donation, items being used most and the shelter it has given to people in need.
- CMF update by David Kirchner. He reminded that the upcoming meeting would include a vote to give funds to LOCC for the driveway and outdoor chapel. There will be an upcoming pancake breakfast.
- June Heckel with the Hospitality Committee said this group along with DWM would be going to the Main Street Music Hall on December 12. They will be having a luncheon the 5th Sunday of the month.
- Pastor Ron thanked all who have served along with the staff. There is an after-school program that starting called KIDZ and volunteers are needed each week. The Shelter in a Storm/Pantry of Blessings is new to the church and he has a great passion for outreach. He also looks forward to Christmas this year since it will not be virtual.
