

All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability. Now there were devout Jews from every people under heaven living in Jerusalem. And at this sound the crowd gathered and was bewildered, because each one heard them speaking in the native language of each. Amazed and astonished, they asked, "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? And how is it that we hear, each of us, in our own native language?
-Acts 2:4-8

On May 28, we will celebrate Pentecost, the coming of the Spirit and the birth of the church. With the Holy Spirit comes a boldness to share the Gospel. Empowerment, conviction, encouragement, courage, and passion--all of these come with the Spirit; and yet, we also marvel at the ways God is able to do a new thing.

Unlike the speaking of tongues told by Paul when a person speaks a garbled, angelic language that needs to be interpreted, here Luke tells how the Holy Spirit enabled those early disciples to literally speak another language so that any person who was visiting was hearing their own native tongue, the language they were most familiar with.

I've often marveled at this gift, for it tells me of the universal language of God. With so many cultures, countries, languages, and dialects, it seems that the Lord has an amazing ability to be able to communicate at our most basic level. Despite all our differences, God can speak to us in a way that is personal, intimate, and says exactly what we need to hear.

The question comes ... are we really listening?

Initially, the primary purpose was to assist members of LOCC by providing rides to medical, dental, and physical therapy appointments in Lake Ozark, Osage Beach, Camdenton, Eldon, Jefferson City, and Columbia. A second purpose was to provide rides to members needing transportation assistance in order to attend services at LOCC.

A survey of LOCC's membership was conducted and many members offered to provide transportation to one (1) or more of the locations listed above. Over time, several of our original group of volunteers have relocated, had changes in their family, or unfortunately passed away. This has created a much smaller "pool" of volunteers.

As a result, we are once again asking for volunteers to provide transportation to locations. Please consider helping us by selecting one (1) or more locations on the sign-up sheet at the information table so we can continue to assist LOCC church members.

Many people in our area have storms of life and need some help. We are able to help with gas cards, motel nights, notes of encouragement, Bibles, food and clothing from monthly donations of our members, and donations of coats, sleeping bags and food boxes from Hope House. Thank you for helping people make it through their personal storms.

The committee keeps an account of what has been donated and what goes out, so please put donations in the bin to have it counted. Hope House is helping us with boxes of food for families, toiletries, sleeping bags and coats. Bibles have been added to the Pantry. We also have gas cards and motel room arrangements for those in need, as well as showers here at church.
